

Obtaining Linux CDP Advanced Edition

To download the Linux CDP 3.18.2 software using R1Soft Customer Portal, perform the following steps:

1. The software for Linux CDP 3.18.2 can be obtained via direct download from the R1Soft website at <https://dist.r1soft.com/download/>.
2. Log in to the R1Soft Customer Portal by entering your User Name and Password in the form on the right-hand side of the screen. Registration is required for all downloads.
