

# Control Panel Add-On - Solved Issue with Bandwidth File

## Symptom

---

A user has a Policy with a created DirectAdmin Control Panel instance.

A bandwidth (for example, `bandwidth.tally`) is created in the `/usr/local/directadmin/data/users` directory.

The Policy task finishes with this alert:

Failed to verify existence of directory '/home/bandwidth.tally' for control panel user 'bandwidth.tally' ('DIRECTADMIN')  
Path not found ([home, bandwidth.tally])

## Resolution

---

The issue has been corrected in CDP 4.2.0. The Policy task now finishes without alerts when a bandwidth is created in the `users` directory.
