

Uninstalling Enterprise Edition on Linux

To remove R1Soft CDP Server Enterprise Edition from your computer, follow the below steps.



Notice

The uninstallation process differs depending whether you're running an RPM (RHE/CentOS/Fedora/Suse/Mandriva) or APT (Debian/Ubuntu) Linux distribution.

RPM/YUM-based Installations | DEB/APT-based Installations

RPM/YUM-based Installations

1. Type the removal command and press <Enter>.

```
rpm -e r1soft-cdp-enterprise-server r1soft-cdp-server r1soft-setup
```

```
[root@centos-server ~]# rpm -e r1soft-cdp-enterprise-server r1soft-cdp-server r1soft-setup
/etc/init.d/cdp-server : cdpserver (no pid file) not running
error reading information on service cdp-server: No such file or directory
R1Soft uninstall has kept /usr/sbin/r1soft and relevant configuration information.
To complete the uninstall, this directory must be removed manually
```

2. The uninstall program stops the CDP Server. It displays information about file removals and may list files that must be removed manually.

3. Once the uninstallation process is complete, R1Soft CDP Server Standard Edition is removed from your computer.

DEB/APT-based Installations

1. Type the removal command and press <Enter>

```
-get remove r1soft-cdp-enterprise-server r1soft-cdp-server r1soft-setup
```

```
root@debian-server:~# apt-get remove r1soft-cdp-enterprise-server r1soft-cdp-server r1soft-setup
Reading package lists... Done
Building dependency tree
Reading state information... Done
The following packages will be REMOVED:
 r1soft-cdp-enterprise-server r1soft-cdp-server r1soft-setup
0 upgraded, 0 newly installed, 3 to remove and 37 not upgraded.

```

2. You will be asked to confirm the uninstallation. Type "Y" and press <Enter> to confirm.

**Tip**

"Yes" is the default answer. To select it, press <Enter>.

```
[root@centos-server ~]# rpm -qa | grep r1soft
r1soft-cdp-async-agent-2-6-3.18.1-16225.x86_64
r1soft-cdp-enterprise-agent-3.18.1-16225.x86_64
r1soft-setup-3.18.1-16225.x86_64
r1soft-cdp-agent-3.18.1-16225.x86_64
[root@centos-server ~]#
```

4. The uninstall program stops the CDP Server. It displays information about file removals and may list files that must be removed manually.

5. Once the uninstallation process is complete, R1Soft CDP Server Enterprise Edition is removed from your computer.
