

Linux Agent CLI - Getting a Kernel Module

R1Soft allows to gets a binary module, without building a module from headers.

Follow instructions below to get a Kernel module and install.

1. Run the `#r1soft-setup` command with the `--binary-only` option.

```
# r1soft-setup --binary-only
```

```
root@r1soft [~]# r1soft-setup --binary-only
```

2. Wait till checking for binary module complete.

```
Checking for binary module
Waiting      -
Complete.
```

```
root@r1soft [~]# r1soft-setup --binary-only
Checking for binary module
Waiting      -
Complete.
```



Note

The default destination for Kernel module is `/lib/modules/r1soft/`.

3. Once module installed, restart the Agent. Run the following command:

```
/etc/init.d/cdp-agent restart
```
