

# Upgrading Standard Edition on CentOS, RHE, and Fedora

To upgrade the Linux CDP Standard Edition to version 3.18.2, log in to the server and perform the following steps.

1. Run the following command:

```
# yum update r1soft-cdp-standard-edition
```

2. Type "Y" and press <Enter> to allow the system to use additional disk space.
3. The upgrade process can take some time.

A Full Block Scan will be initiated after an agent upgrade, due to a restart of the agent service/daemon. This ensures replicas are consistent, even after a server crash or reboot. For more information, or to better understand backup types, see "Benefits of CDP."

4. After the upgrade is complete, execute the following command to make sure that version 3.18.2 has been installed:

```
# rpm -qa | grep r1soft
```
