

Linux Agent CLI - Viewing Agent's Status

To see the status of the agent, run the following `#cdp-agent` command with the `status` option:

```
# /etc/init.d/cdp-agent status
```

Return:

- Case1. Agent is running:

```
/etc/init.d/cdp-agent status: cdp (pid 3460) running
```

```
root@r1soft [~]# /etc/init.d/cdp-agent status
/etc/init.d/cdp-agent status: cdp (pid 3460) running
```

- Case 2. Agent is not running:

```
/etc/init.d/cdp-agent status: cdp (no pid file) not running
```

```
root@r1soft [~]# /etc/init.d/cdp-agent status
/etc/init.d/cdp-agent status: cdp (no pid file) not running
```
