

# Linux Agent CLI - Stopping The Agent

To stop the running CDP Agent, follow the instructions below.

1. Run the `#cdp-agent` command using the `stop` option:

```
# /etc/init.d/cdp-agent stop
```

Return:

```
/etc/init.d/cdp-agent stop: cdp stopped
```

```
root@rlsoft [~]# /etc/init.d/cdp-agent stop  
/etc/init.d/cdp-agent stop: cdp stopped
```

2. Verify the Agent's status using the `status` option of the same command:

```
# /etc/init.d/cdp-agent status
```

Return:

You should now receive a message that the Agent is not running.

```
/etc/init.d/cdp-agent status: cdp (no pid file) not running
```

```
root@rlsoft [~]# /etc/init.d/cdp-agent status  
/etc/init.d/cdp-agent status: cdp (no pid file) not running
```
