

## Accessing CDP Configuration Utility

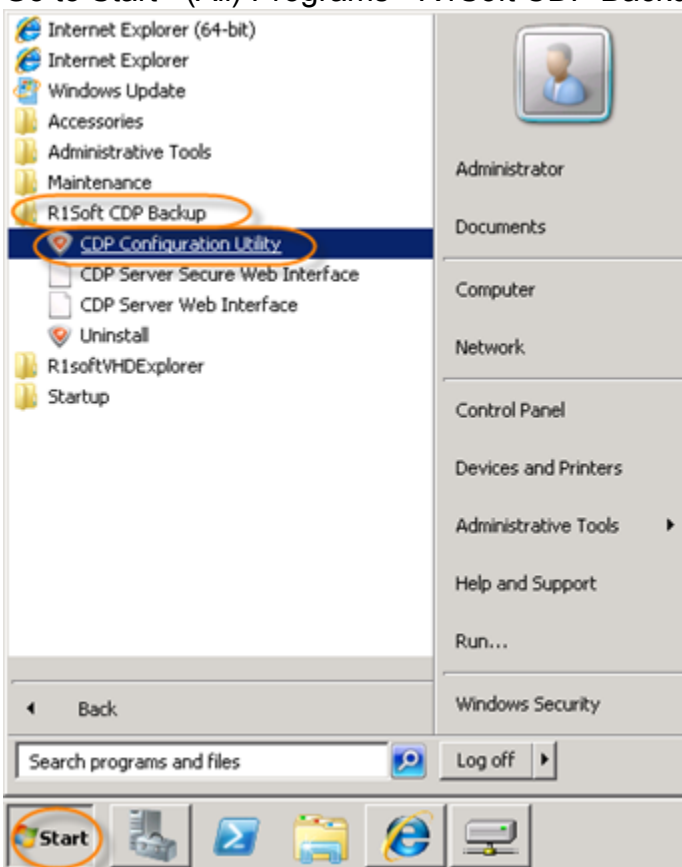
Follow the instructions below to access the [Windows CDP Configuration Utility](#).



### Note

For Enterprise Edition, CDP Configuration Utility is available on the machine with CDP Server installed. On the machine where CDP Agent is installed, use [Windows CDP Agent Configuration Utility](#).

Go to Start > (All) Programs > R1Soft CDP Backup > CDP Configuration Utility.
