

# Utilizing LSB Exit Codes by CDP Server and Agent Init Scripts

## Product Improvement

---

`cdp-server` and `cdp-agent` `init` scripts now return Linux Standard Base (LSB)-compliant exit status codes.

For STATUS requests, the following exit codes are supported:

**0** program is running or service is OK  
**1** program is dead and `/var/run` pid file exists  
**3** program is not running

For START requests, these additional codes are supported:

**5** program is not installed  
**6** program is not configured
