

# Solved Issue with CDP Server Upgrade Causing Users to Lose Agent Assignments

## Symptom

---

Upgrading caused all users to be unassigned from their Agents.

## Resolution

---

The issue has been corrected in CDP 4.2.0. Agent assignments are no longer removed after an upgrade.
