

## Accessing Configuration in CDP Server

Follow the instructions below to access the Configuration in your CDP Server Standard Edition.

Click on "Configuration" in the Main Menu to open the "Configuration" window.

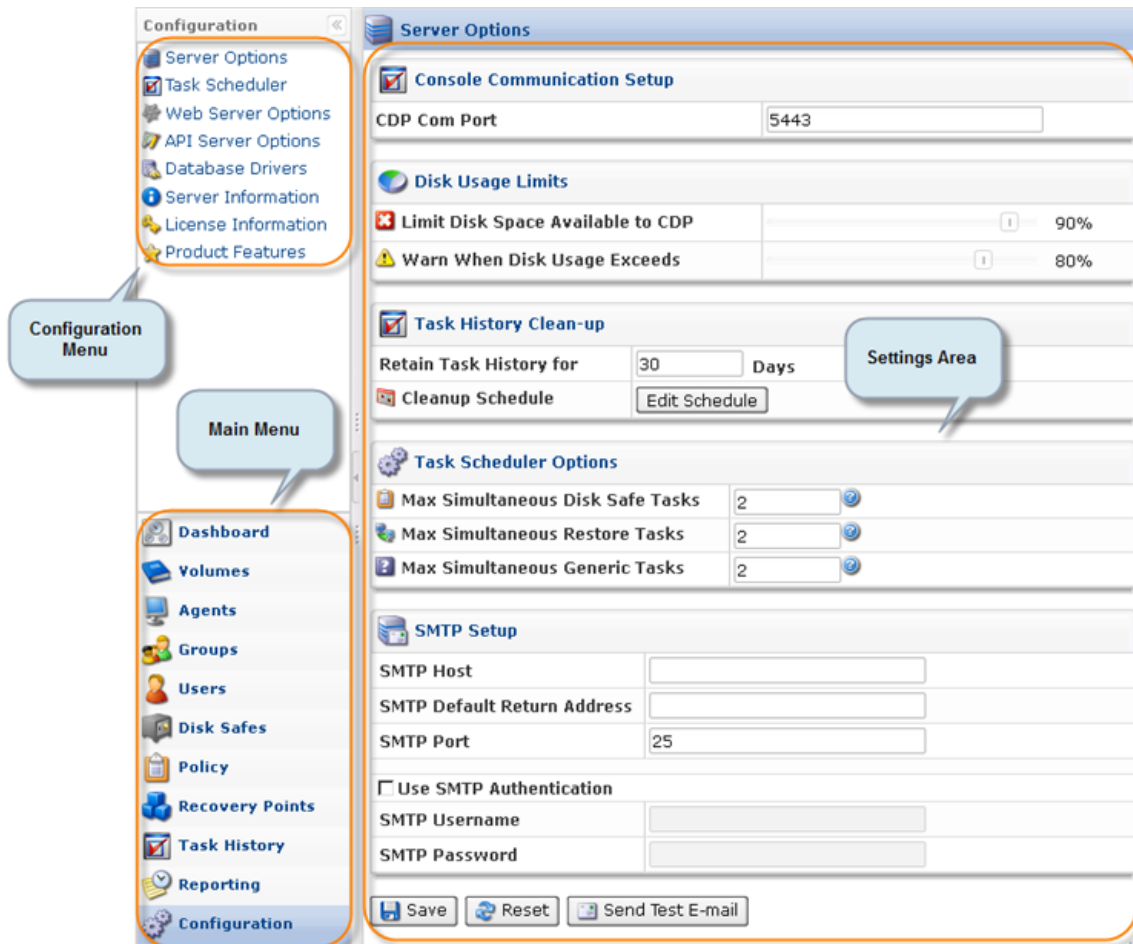
### Tip

You can access the "Configuration" window by manually appending the /Configuration/ folder to the CDP Server address in the browser address bar. Example: <http://10.61.200.31/Configuration/>. Note that the address is case sensitive.
